6. Talked with Mr. Allen E. Reed of the Bureau of the Budget concerning the health insurance bill (S. 94) now pending with the Senate Post Office and Civil Service Committee. At Reed's suggestion a draft of our proposed reply letter to the Committee on this bill was forwarded to him for informal review.

7. Talked with [] (OSI) concerning our visit with Congressman James C. Oliver (D., Maine) on the subject of cesium. (See Journal of 23 April) [] mentioned that a member of his office had been informed through a contact in the Bureau of Mines that Oliver has received fairly positive reports through a Baltimore intelligence organization (presumably INFORM) to the effect that the Russians are stockpiling cesium. This report was discussed with ORR [] They are looking into the matter further.

8. Col. Grogan called in connection with an item relating to an inquiry from Congressman Bob Wilson (R., Calif.) on the Soviet "Spy City." Col. Grogan was interested in the source of our comment to Wilson.
