1. The meeting consisted primarily of reviewing the attached list of STAP working groups and considering the status of each. A summary of this discussion follows. The meeting concluded with a consideration of two of the new topics that the DCI suggested at the September 1980 STAP meeting--Long-range S&T issues and economic S&T intelligence. []

Working Group Status

2. ELINT. A memo on this subject has gone to the DCI. To date, STAP has received no feedback. [] discussed the subject with [] the Executive Secretary of the SIGINT Overhead Reconnaissance Subcommittee (SORS). It was agreed that [] should meet with both the SORS and with Evan Hineman to continue discussions of SIGINT. []

3. Secure Communications. [] is approximately half-finished with a first draft. []

4. Presidential Candidates Briefing. [] mentioned that he had received a thank you letter from Bruce Clarke for the memo that STAP sent to him on this subject. Other than that, there has been no feedback. []

5. The S&T Cycles Paper. Steve Lukasik is rewriting the paper. He has received comments from [] which describe the problems but do not suggest any solutions. It was agreed that Steve should be called to see about coming in to work on the paper. []
