Libya is dedicated to acquiring an indigenous capability to produce ballistic missiles. We believe Tripoli currently has two surface-to-surface missiles under development, both heavily dependent on foreign assistance.

## PROSPECTS

Libya lacks the modern technological and industrial base necessary to indigenously produce a potentially nuclear-capable ballistic missile. However, if the Libyans receive continued substantial foreign assistance they could develop their own missile system in as little as five years. Until that time, the Sovietsupplied SCUD with a range of 300-km probably will remain Qadhafi's principal missile. Nuclear warhead production is equally beyond Libya's capabilities and foreign assistance probably will be much more difficult to obtain. A nuclear-armed ballistic missile is unlikely to appear in Qadhafi's arsenal for a long time, certainly not within the next decade.
