CHAD (SWN) 25X1 REMARKS: LIBYAN MILITARY FORCES DEPLOYED IN CHAD, AS SEEN 2. ON IMAGERY 25X1 INCLUDED ELEMENTS OF FOUR MECHANIZED INFANTRY BATTALIONS (NONE WITH THE FULL COMPLEMENT OF 40 ARMORED VEHICLES), TWO PROBABLE MOTORIZED INFANTRY BATTALIONS, TWO TANK COMPANIES AND THREE TANK PLATOONS, ELEMENTS OF ONE MULTIPLE ROCKET LAUNCHER (MRL) BATTERY, FOUR 130MM FIELD GUN M-46 BATTERIES, THREE 122MM HOWITZER D-30 BATTERIES, ELEMENTS OF SIX HEAVY-LIFT BATTALIONS, AND NUMEROUS SUPPORT VEHICLES. AIR DEFENSE EQUIPMENT INCLUDED TWO SA-6 (GAINFUL) BATTERIES (NOT OPERATIONAL THREE SA-9 (GASKIN) 25X1 TRANSPORTER-ERECTOR-LAUNCHERS (TEL), AND THREE ZSU-23/4 SELF-PROPELLED ANTIAIRCRAFT GUNS (SPAAG). LIBYAN COMBAT AIRCRAFT IN NORTHERN CHAD INCLUDED SIX MIRAGE F-1 FIGHTER/BOMBERS, 23 FITTER (SU-22) FIGHTER/BOMBERS, 19 SF.260 LIGHT-STRIKE AIRCRAFT, AND SIX HIND ATTACK HELICOPTERS. THESE LIBYAN MILITARY FORCES HAVE DEPLOYED TO FIVE LOCATIONS IN NORTHERN CHAD -- FAYA LARGEAU, OUNIANGA KEBIR, GOURO, OGOUI, AND AOZOU. 25X1 THE LIBYAN GROUND FORCES OBSERVED AT FAYA LARGEAU INCLUDED ELEMENTS OF ONE MECHANIZED 25X1 INFANTRY BATTALION (ONLY 12 ARMORED VEHICLES OBSERVED), ONE PROBABLE MOTORIZED INFANTRY BATTALION (48 LAND ROVER-TYPE VEHICLES AND 33 TRUCKS), ONE TANK PLATOON (FIVE MEDIUM TANKS), ELEMENTS OF ONE BM-21 MULTIPLE ROCKET LAUNCHER BATTERY (AT LEAST TWO MRL), THREE 122MM HOWITZER D-30 BATTERIES (NINE GUNS, ONLY TWO BATTERIES DEPLOYED), ELEMENTS OF TWO HEAVY-LIFT BATTALIONS (30 TRANSPORTERS), AND A LOGISTICS UNIT (AT LEAST 65 TRUCKS). ALTHOUGH THE NUMBERS OF ARMORED VEHICLES CONFIRMED ON POOR IMAGERY

Page $\frac{2}{}$ of $\frac{3}{}$ Z-13962/83 Attachment to NPIC/IEG (8/83) Copy__ 25 AUGUST 1983 25X1 IN THE FAYA LARGEAU AREA DID NOT EQUATE TO A NORMAL LIBYAN MECHANIZED BATTALION (40 PER BATTALION), THE CONTINUED PRESENCE OF 30 HEAVY-LIFT TRANSPORTERS, WHICH CARRY MECHANIZED UNITS, SUGGESTED THAT MORE ARMORED VEHICLES WERE DEPLOYED THAN COULD BE SEEN. EXCEPT FOR SMALL FLUCTUATIONS IN VEHICLE COUNTS, THE ONLY SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN LIBYAN GROUND FORCES SINCE FAYA LARGEAU WAS RECAPTURED ON WAS THE IDENTIFICATION 25X1 OF A THIRD 122MM HOWITZER D-30 BATTERY. (SWN) LIBYAN GROUND FORCES AT OUNIANGA KEBIR WFRE ESSENTIALLY LIBYAN UNITS OBSERVED HERE ON UNCHANGED 25X1 INCLUDED ELEMENTS OF TWO MECHANIZED INFANTRY 25X1 BATTALIONS (27 BMP AND BTR-60 ARMORED PERSONNEL CARRIERS (APC)), ONE TANK COMPANY (13 MEDIUM TANKS), TWO 130MM FIELD GUN M-46 BATTERIES (TEN GUNS), ELEMENTS OF TWO HEAVY-LIFT BATTALIONS (34 TRANSPORTERS), AND A LOGISTICS UNIT (120 TRUCKS). SIX SF.260 LIGHT-STRIKE AIRCRAFT, ONE CURL TRANSPORT, ONE TWIN OTTER TRANSPORT, AND TWO HIP HELICOPTERS WERE ALSO AT THE AIRFIELD ON THAT DATE. ALTHOUGH 20 ARMORED VEHICLES AND APPROXIMATELY 30 HEAVY-LIFT TRANSPORTERS HAD RECENTLY DEPARTED THE OUNIANGA KEBIR AREA, TWO MECHANIZED INFANTRY BATTALIONS (ONE BMP APC AND ONE BTR-60 APC) REMAINED HERE. (SWN) THE MOST RECENT DEPLOYMENT OF LIBYAN GROUND FORCES IN NORTHERN CHAD WAS OBSERVED AT GOURO. THIS 25X1 FORCE CONSISTED OF ELEMENTS OF ONE MECHANIZED INFANTRY BATTALION (29 BMP APC AND OTHER ARMORED VEHICLES), ONE TANK PLATOON (FOUR MEDIUM TANKS), ELEMENTS OF TWO HEAVY-LIFT BATTALIONS (35 TRANSPORTERS), ONE 130MM FIELD GUN M-46 BATTERY (FIVE GUNS), AND ONE LOGISTICS UNIT (53 TRUCKS). AN F-27 TRANSPORT AIRCRAFT WAS SEEN AT GOURO AIRFIELD ON THIS SAME DATE. (SWN) LIBYAN FORCES AT OGOUI REMAINED ESSENTIALLY UNCHANGED SINCE 25X1 AND INCLUDED ELEMENTS OF A PROBABLE MOTORIZED INFANTRY/CAMMANDO BATTALION (17 LAND ROVER-TYPE VEHICLES AND AT LEAST FOUR TRUCKS), ONE TANK PLATOON (THREE MEDIUM

ALTHOUGH VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT AT OGOUI REMAINED UNCHANGED 25X1 THE IDENTIFICATION OF WEAPONS PLATFORMS MOUNTED ON SOME OF THE LAND ROVERS AMONG THE FORCES PRESENT INDICATED THAT ELEMENTS OF AN INFANTRY/CAMMANDO UNIT WERE PRESENT. THE AIR ORDER-OF-BATTLE AT OGOUI REMAINED NORMAL AND CONSISTED OF SIX SF.260 LIGHT-STRIKE AIRCRAFT, ONE CH-47, AND TWO HIND. (SWN) LIBYAN GROUND FORCES HAD ALSO BEEN DEPLOYED TO AOZOU AIRFIELD 25X1 REVEALED ONE TANK COMPANY (EIGHT PROBABLE AND THREE CONFIRMED MEDIUM TANKS), ONE 130MM FIELD GUN M-46 BATTERY (FOUR GUNS), TEN HEAVY-LIFT TRANSPORTERS, AND APPROXIMATELY 55 TRUCKS AND OTHER VEHICLES HAD RECENTLY ARRIVED. ORDER-OF-BATTLE AT THE AIRFIELD REMAINED NORMAL WITH SIX MIRAGE F-1 FIGHTER/BOMBERS, 23 FITTER FIGHTER/BOMBERS, SEVEN SF.260 LIGHT-STRIKE AIRCRAFT, TWO HIP HELICOPTERS AND ONE ALOUETTE III HELICOPTER. THE FUEL STORAGE CAPACITY AT THE AIRFIELD WAS SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASED 25X1 WHEN A TOTAL OF 31 FUEL BLADDERS WAS SEEN NEAR THE. AIRFIELD. AIR DEFENSE HAD ALSO BEEN INCREASED WITH THE ARRIVAL OF TWO PROBABLE SA-6 BATTERIES 25X1 WHICH HAD NOT YET BEEN OPERATIONALLY DEPLOYED. ADDITIONAL AIR DEFENSE INCLUDED THREE SA-9 TEL AND THREE ZSU-23/4 SPAAG. FIVE SA-9 WERE PRESENT ELECTRONICS AT THE 25X1 AIRFIELD INCLUDED A NEWLY DEPLOYED UNIDENTIFIED RADAR, ONE FLAT FACE AIR WARNING RADAR, ONE SPOON REST AIR WARNING RADAR, ONE SATELLITE COMMUNICATIONS STATION, AND ONE RSBN-4 NAVIGATIONAL AID.
