1. **SIGNIFICANCE:** PROBABLE LONG-RANGE CRUISE MISSILE LAUNCH PREPARATIONS ARE CONTINUING. (SWN)
2. **REMARKS:** TWO NITROGEN TRUCKS, ONE MISSILE-ASSOCIATED RAILCAR, AND TWO POSSIBLE TRAILERS ARE NEAR THE ENTRANCE OF ONE OF THE ASSEMBLY/CHECKOUT BUILDINGS AT KAPUSTIN YAR COMPLEX C
 ASSEMBLY CHECKOUT AREA (RIGHT GRAPHIC), POSSIBLY INDICATING THAT AT LEAST ONE CRUISE MISSILE AIRFRAME HAS BEEN DELIVERED AND IS BEING PREPARED FOR A FUTURE FLIGHT TEST. THE TWO NITROGEN TRUCKS ARE BACKED UP TO THE BUILDING AT A 90 DEGREE ANGLE TO EACH OTHER AND ARE PROBABLY RELATED TO THE CHECKOUT/PREPARATION OF THE CRUISE MISSILE AIRFRAME. SIMILAR NITROGEN TRUCKS HAVE BEEN OBSERVED BESIDE A TRANSPORTER-LOADER AT KAPUSTIN YAR COMPLEX C SITE 2 PRIOR TO THE LAUNCH OF THE NEW PROBABLE LONG-RANGE CRUISE MISSILE (LEFT GRAPHIC). THIS ACTIVITY IS PROBABLY RELATED TO PRELAUNCH ACTIVITY WHICH HAS BEEN IN PROGRESS AT KAPUSTIN YAR COMPLEX C SITE 2 (SWN)
