## PRELIMINARY ELECTION RESULTS IN CHILE

Election returns in Chile up to midnight of 4 September, according to a radio report from Santiago, showed former dictator-president Carlos Ibanez del Campo in the lead with 362,706 votes. Rightist candidate Matte Larrain had 217,035 votes, and the government-backed Pedro Enrique Alfonso had only 148,435. The extreme leftist candidate had received merely 48,735 votes. The total vote is expected to be approximately 900,000.
