**Additional Security Measures  
Regarding Recent Missions**

1. The Chairman distributed a paper which he had prepared as a result of the last ARC meeting which General Cabell was unwilling to approve. General Cabell requested that increased security restrictions be devised with regard to the approach on recent missions and highly sensitive AE and GM subjects as would be affected in the utilization of the photography [Redacted]. The Committee discussed the subject at length and failed to devise any new restrictive measures which would be practical and effective in meeting General Cabell's request without serious expansion of the bureaucracy to handle the matters or without serious impediment to the effective exploitation.

2. The Chairman adjourned the meeting with the remark that he would consider the matter further and see if he could come up with any acceptable measures.
