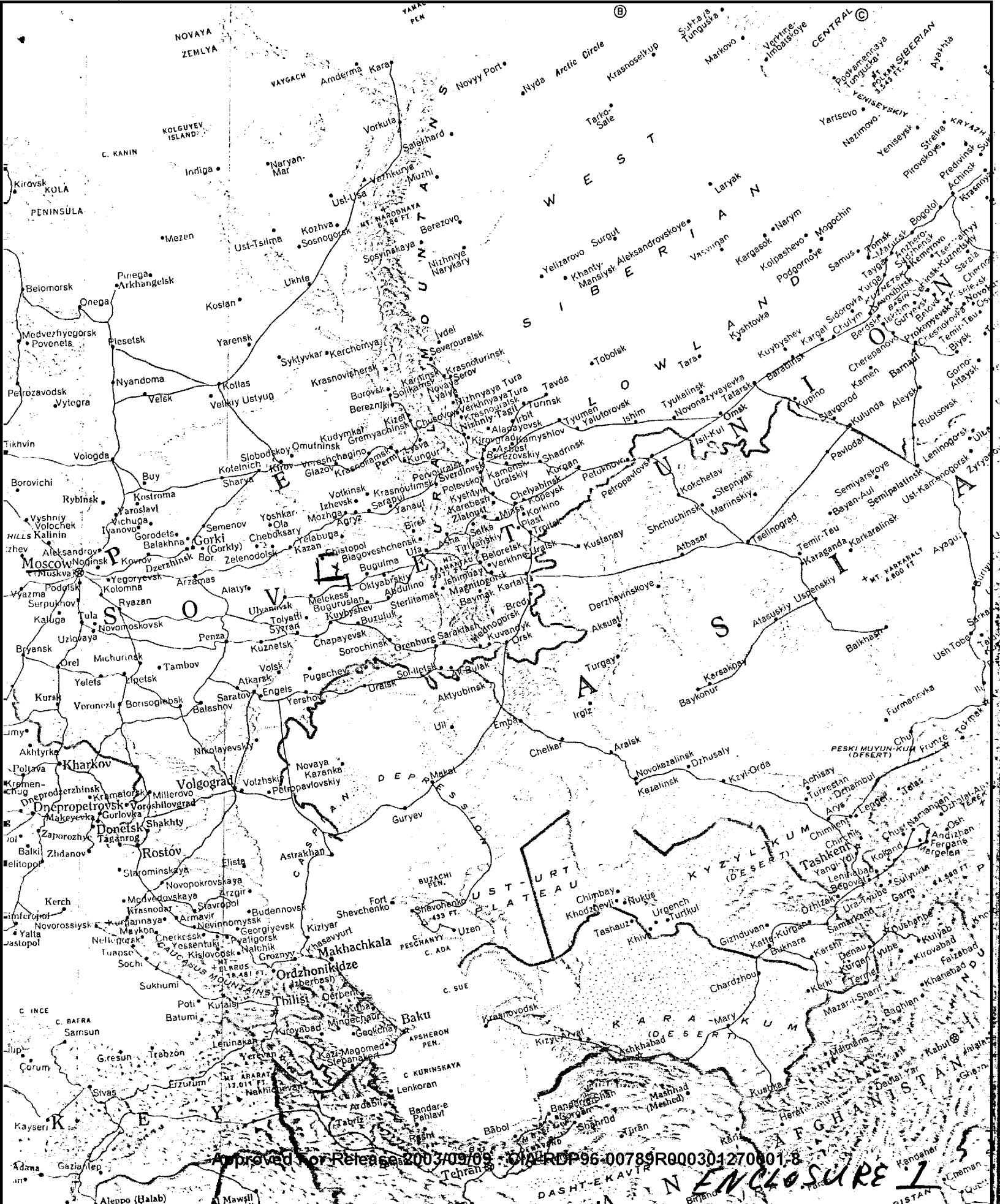

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

SG1A Target [] is located west southwest of Moscow and in the vicinity of Bugulma and Blagoveshchensk, in the Soviet Union.

SG1A SEE ENCLOSURE 1. [] is being utilized to modernize and upgrade the symmetry and designs of what appears to be the Soviet "Blackjack" bomber. The upgrade and improvements are mainly SIGINT-related and deal mainly with improvements related to electro-optics, telemetry, radar and radar-jamming. The Soviets feel that as a result of the upgrade, the "Blackjack" is ideally suited to be used as a low level flying strategic and intelligence gathering aircraft. Manned exclusively Soviet crews, it is occasionally and currently used in third world countries for such strategic purposes. In addition, the "Blackjack" can readily be retrofitted for chemical warfare use. There are an estimated 200 to 350 "Blackjack" aircraft in the Soviet inventory. Thirteen aircraft are "ready to go" (retrofitting completed?) while another 16 are being worked on.

SG1A A (principal) warehouse located immediately left of Target [] serves as a logistical support base for this operation. SEE ENCLOSURE 2.



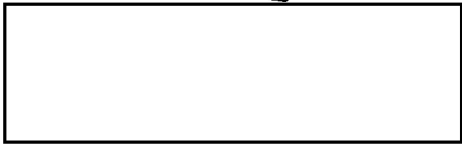
