Site was perceived as open, rolling, grass-covered terrain, with intermittent light and shadows "like" clouds moving across the sun on a pleasant, peaceful spring day. Off in the distance were patches of blue green trees, buildings, and human activity, but here was only quiet and bird sounds. It reminded me of a meadow in an agrarian area that was left fallow to grow wild grass and flowers. There were no people around. There was an impression of scattered yet somewhat ordered white, hard objects that were "like" stone or masonry, and had been chiseled or carved. All here of a quiet, lonely peaceful feeling. Area was interspersed with rolling hills and small valleys.

When pressed for an answer, 003 replied that based on his analysis of the results of his viewing, LTC Higgins was dead. Note, 003 was the only viewer of seven who did not find LTC Higgins alive.
