SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

THE TARGET PRESENTED ITSELF IN FOUR SEPARATE PARTS, OR ASPECTS OF THE WHOLE. EACH PART IS KEYED TO THE SKETCHES NUMBERED ONE THROUGH FOUR.

- 1. THE FIRST ASPECT OF THE TARGET WAS A VISUAL REPRESENTATION OF A FLOWER.
 THIS WAS AN UNUSUAL FLOWER, IN THAT IT LOOKED VERY MUCH LIKE A LARGE DAISY,
 BUT HAD THE COLORATION OF A SUNFLOWER. THE CENTER WAS DARK BROWN AND
 THE PETALS WERE A RICH, GOLDEN YELLOW. I HAD THE FEELING OF BEING OUTDOORS
 AND OF SOMEONE ADMIRING AND INTERACTING WITH THIS FLOWER.
- 2. THE NEXT ASPECT WAS A FEELING OF MOTION, A HORIZONTAL, SPIRALLING, CORKSCREW-LIKE MOTION. ALONG WITH THIS FEELING OF MOTION WAS THE IMPRESSION OF SPEED AND CENTRIFUGAL FORCE.
- 3. I FIND MYSELF TRAVELING IN SOME SORT OF VEHICLE, I AM DRAWN TO A DARK-HAIRED WOMAN SITTING NEXT TO A LARGE WINDOW ON THE LEFT-HAND SIDE OF THIS VEHICLE. SHE IS LOOKING AWAY FROM ME AND APPEARS TO BE DAYDREAMING WHILE WATCHING THE SCENERY PASS BY.
- 4. THE FOURTH ASPECT OF THIS TARGET WAS INTERESTING AND MOST UNUSUAL. THE SCENE CONSISTED OF A QUAINT, OLD WOODEN BUILDING SITUATED ON, OR ADJACENT TO A LARGE, RAISED PLATFORM IN A RURAL SETTING. HOWEVER, THIS SCENE HAD AN UNREAL, ALMOST DREAM-LIKE QUALITY TO IT. I HAD THE FEELING OF BEING INDOORS AS I VIEWED THIS SCENE, AS IF IT WERE A MODEL RAILROAD LAYOUT, OR A MUSEUM DIORAMA.
