SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

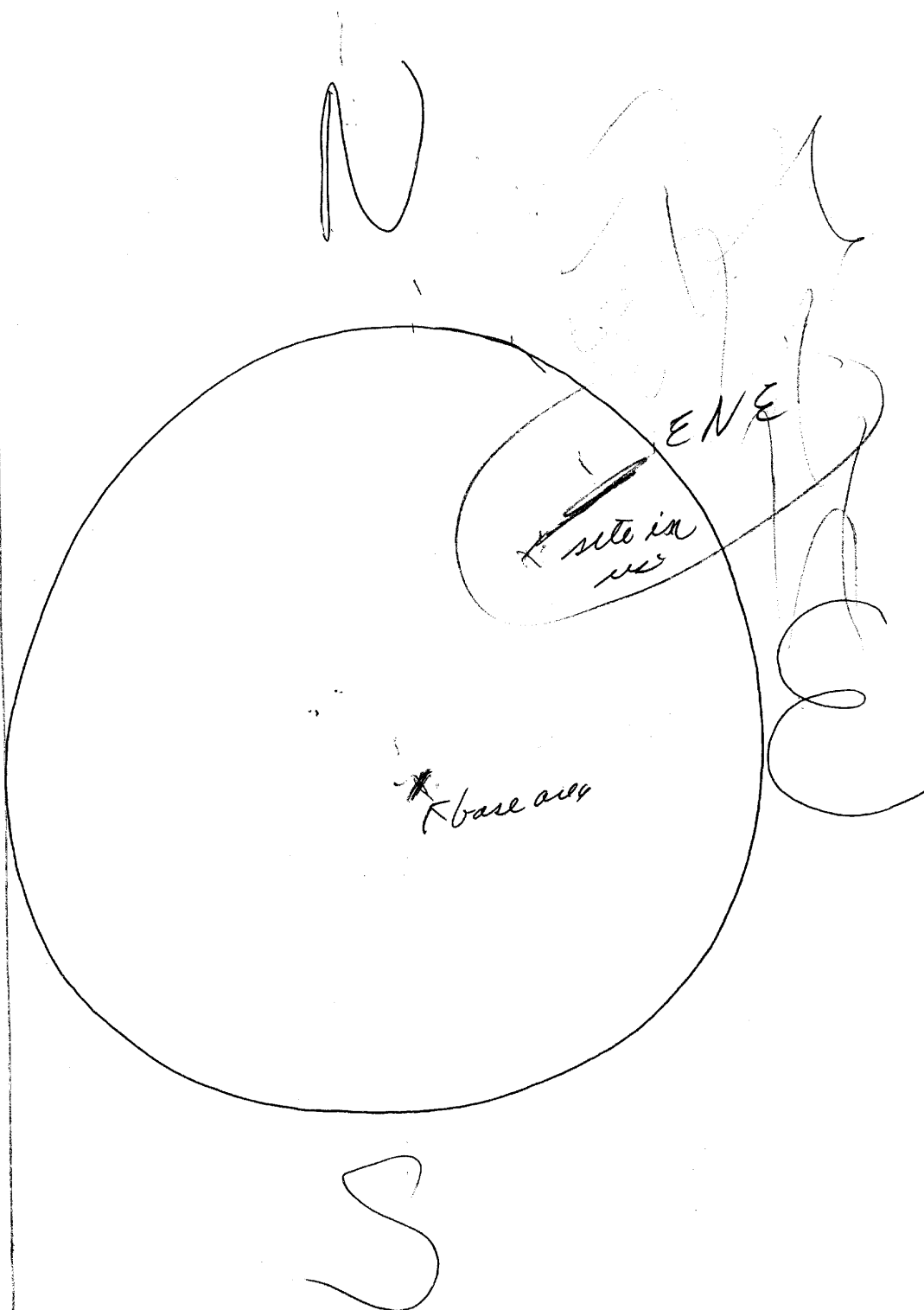
An airdrop was aborted in the past. An aircraft^a will make a drop at two locations from 7 - 11 July 1990. The first location is approximately 80 miles south of the Dominican Republic near the border of Haiti at 17 10'N / 71 50'W. The second is approximately 110 miles south of La Romana in the Dominican Republic at 17 50' N / 68 50'W. It is a silver, two engine aircraft, with some red on it. The airfield has air strips and buildings. A main base area is centrally located and the aircraft was sited east north east on the complex near a supplies building.

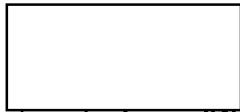
