5. COMMENTS: EEI are listed in order of importance. If requested search locations are not within the borders indicated, please so state.

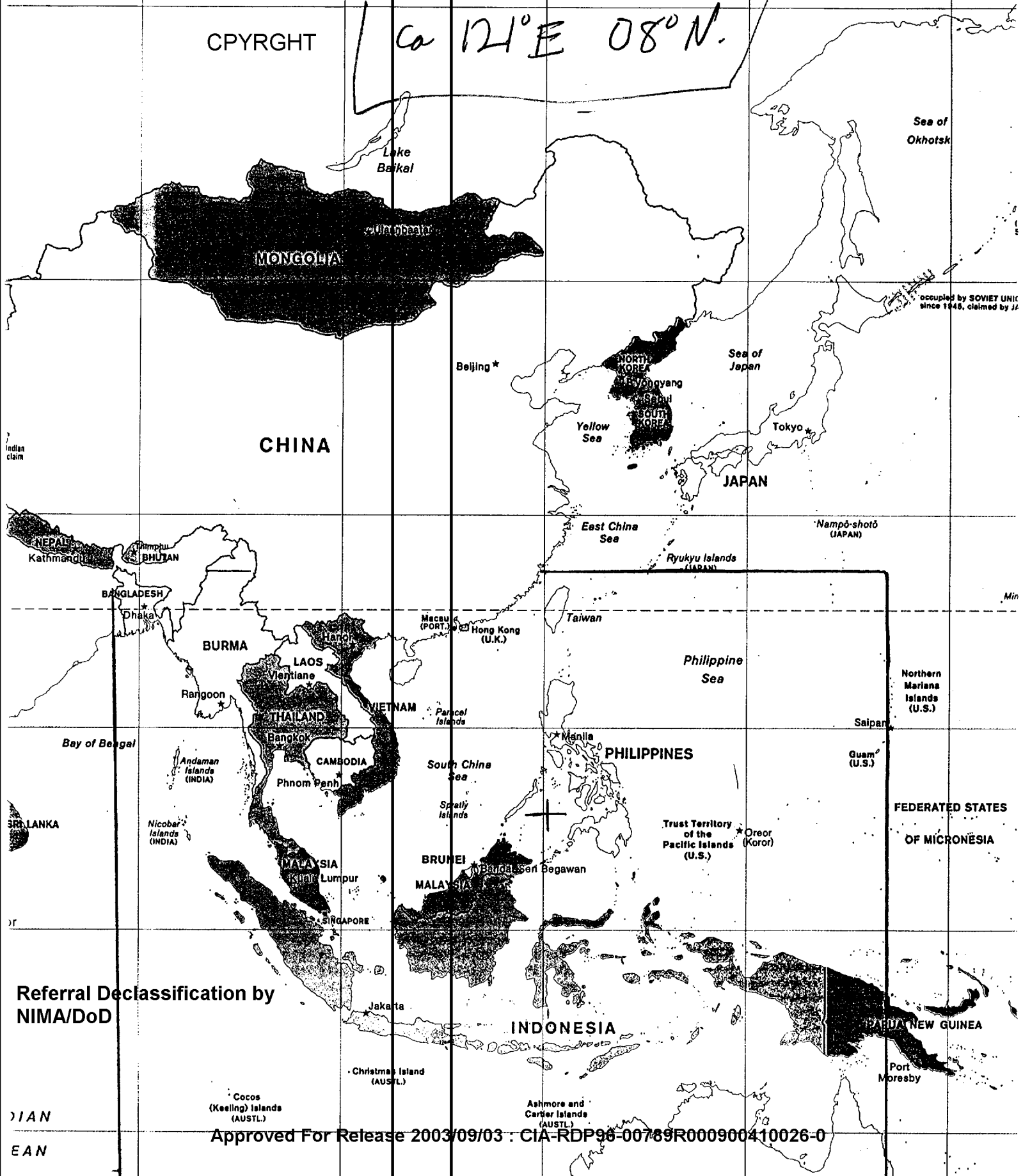
