

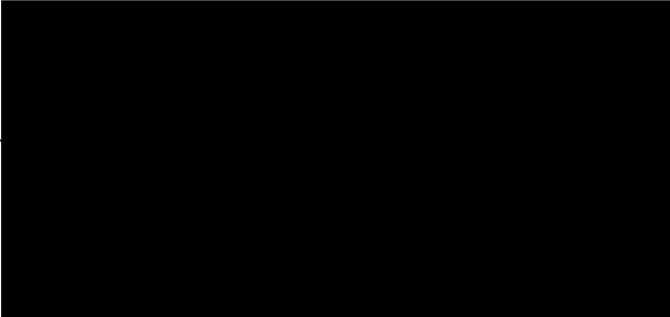

Ref: STAR GATE briefing to  USA, Deputy Director for Operations, United States Army Foreign Counterintelligence Activity (USAFCA), FT. Meade, MD, 15 Feb 94.

1. (S/NF/WN) On 4 Apr 94,  USA, Deputy Director for Operations and Investigations, United States Army Foreign Counterintelligence Activity, (USAFAC) USAINSCOM. Also in attendance were  Chief of Operations, and  Chief of Investigations, USAFAC.

2. (S/NF/WN/SG/LIMDIS) This meeting was a follow-on to our briefing and discussions of 15 Feb 94 to explore a possible joint work effort. Discussions included a historical and current update on the operational activity of the STAR GATE Program. As a result,  requested our assistance in support of their operations and investigative mission, and taskings were accepted. Due to the nature of USAFAC's requirements, the legal ramifications for this joint effort were discussed. Our support will be governed by procedures 2 and 5-10, DIAM 5240.1R and Army Regulation 380-10. The undersigned coordinated this joint effort with DIA's GC who interposed no objections.
