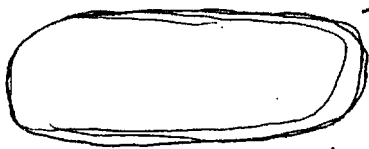
Vessel "BB" seems to be a medium-sized metal cargo vessel, somewhat ^{relatively} slower. White trim ^{raised} forward ^{curved} ~~portion~~ portion. Superstructure aft. Rust streaked. Funnel seems to be orangish-red. Vessel smokes alot. There's a lime-green color apparently associated (neither hull or superstructure) - superstructure primarily off white - some black details dark-colored hull. Impression of things stacked forward of superstructure.

Contraband is located in a closed, stuffy, metal-walled space and is packed in brown, card-board-like containers with plastic sheeting inside wrapping contents, which are white, granular-like. Tide flat has been wet + dried - lumpy. Hard. Its' located forward of superstructure just aft of midships slightly below deck line, but above water line slightly.
