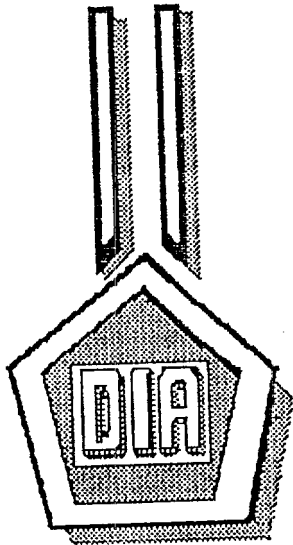

SUMMARY

1. (S/NF/LIMDIS) TASK: Describe activities associated with target as specified in sealed envelope.
2. (U) PRIOR REPORTING: None; this is initial response.
3. (U) RESPONSES:
  - a. (U) SOURCE: 025.
    - (1) (U) DATE OF INFORMATION: 02 Jan 91.
    - (2) (S/NF/LIMDIS) DATA SUMMARY:
      - (a) Target is associated with middle east:
        - Target area includes buildings, hills, dunes.
        - Site uses general camouflage techniques.
        - Something is hidden/stored in the dunes that is intended for release.
        - Guns may be present, and may have recently fired.
        - Area may have a loading/staging role (equipment may involve planes, trucks).
        - Area may also have a role in people retention or capturing, possibly torture, and in money transfer.
      - (b) Overall activity at area associated with planning actions for structuring/restructuring, and for movement of troops to boundary areas. Future armament limitations may also be part of planning considerations.
      - (c) A leader may be present at site for planning future actions.

(2) (S/NF/LIMDIS) DATA SUMMARY:

(a) Key aspects of target area are hidden or underground. Some features include:

- Shiny metallic square-shaped surfaces.
- "V" shaped trench shapes.
- Cone shaped objects.
- Circular, grate-like objects (fig 1).
- Semi-circular objects (fig 2).

(b) Several different activities may be associated with target area and include:

- High energy light generation.
- Heat generation with hazardous hot spots.
- Mechanical activity involving pumping or moving of spheres.
- Solar energy production/research.

(2) (S/NF/LIMDIS) DATA SUMMARY:

(a) Target associated with a small country (possible an island country):

- Countryside has low hills and is very dry.
- Ships (white vessels) may be nearby.
- Activity of interest centers on unusual containers:

- o Containers are associated with war plans and west to east movement (some type of shooting or firing).

- o Containers are (or will be) placed near hills at perimeter of country.

(b) There may be some type of TV communication link or network with (or to) a tunnel-associated location.

- There seems to be a watching/waiting role.

(c) People association:

- Young people are involved in the communication link or network.

- A leader-type person is at or associated with the communication area.

- This leader-type person will soon experience a downfall.

a. (U) Of above responses, source 079 is most experienced.

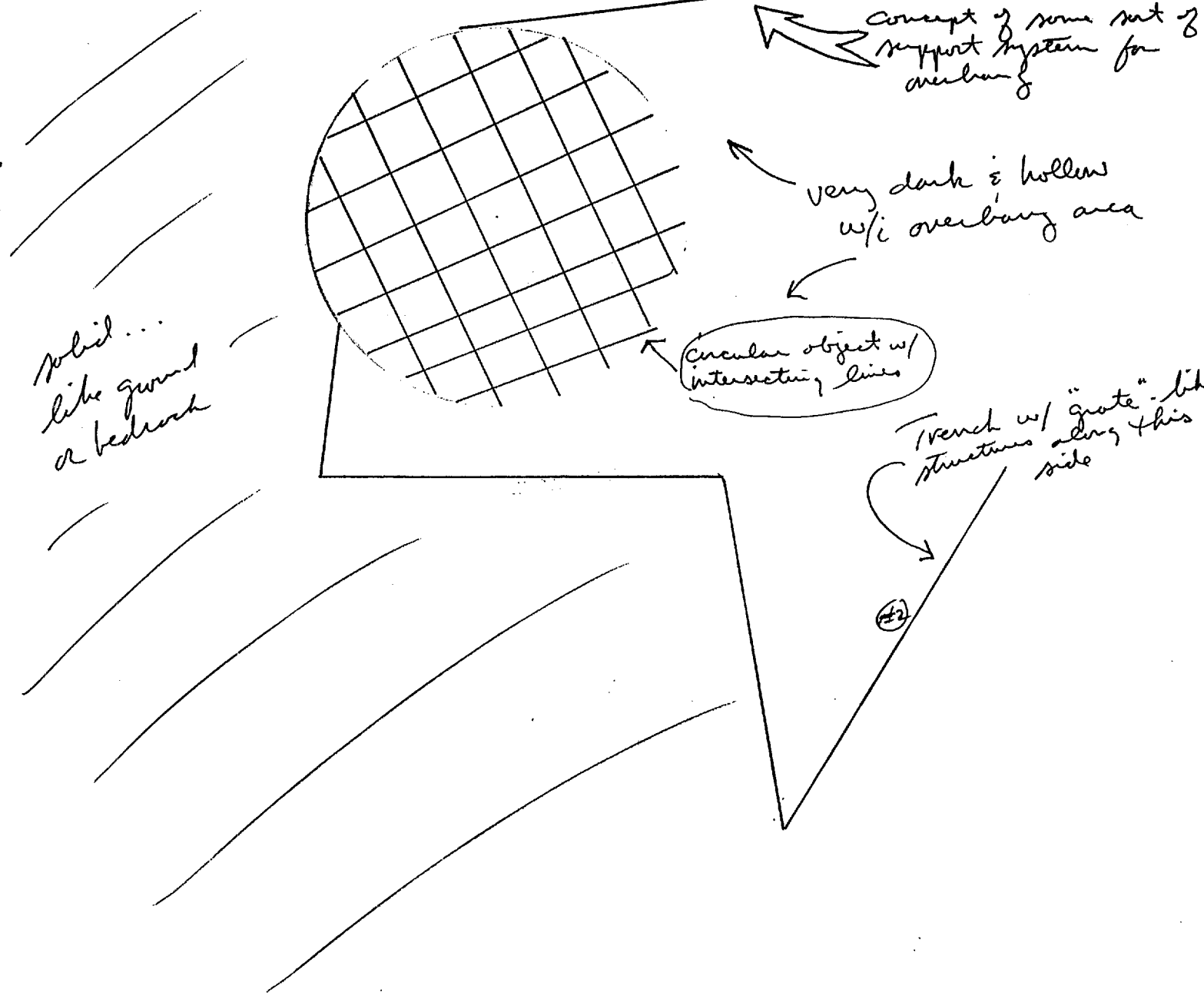

Trench w/ "grate"-like structures along this side

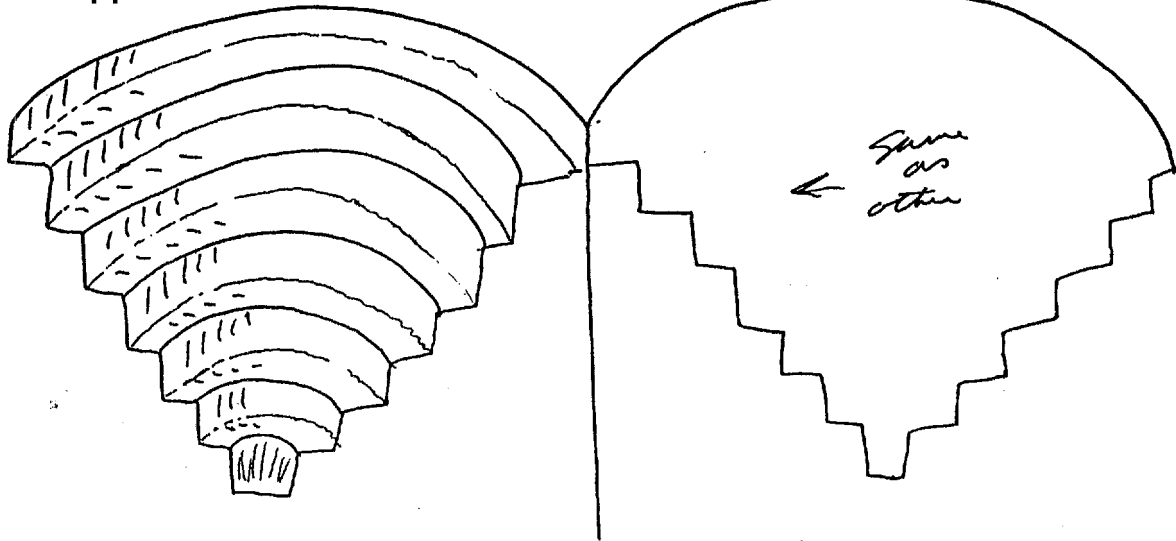
solid... like ground or bedrock

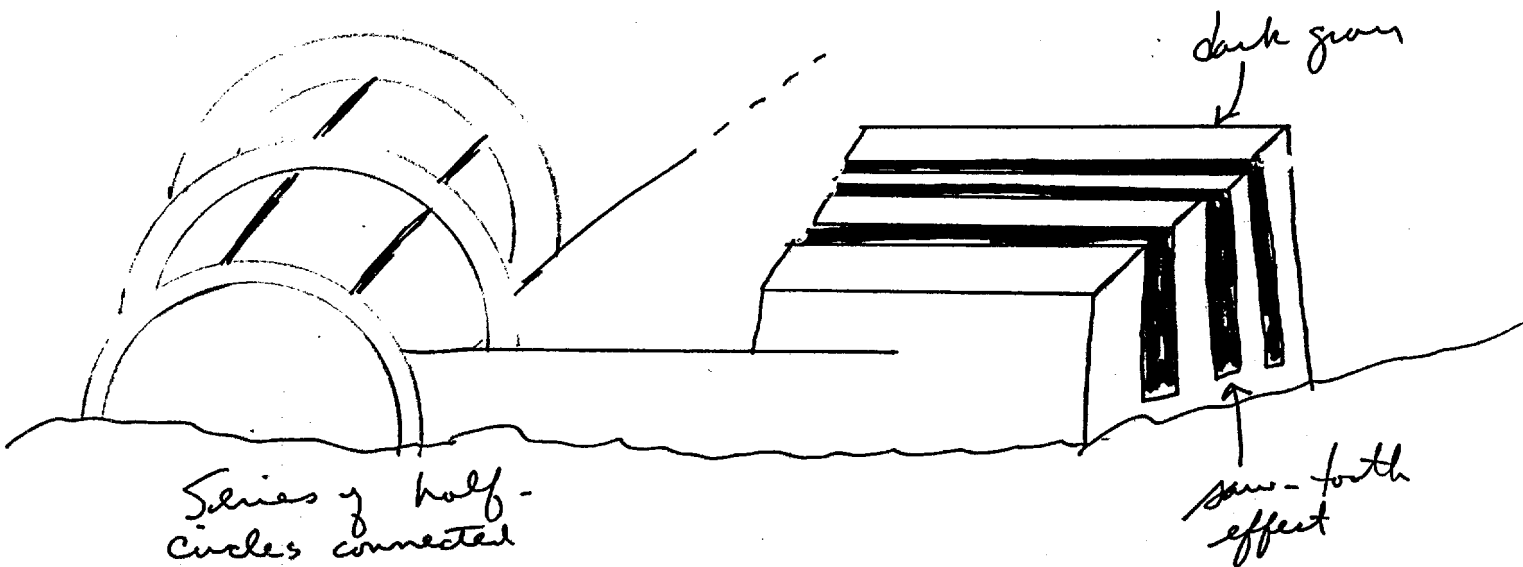
