FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE

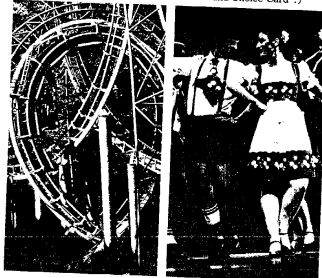
