

STEAKERY OF IMPORMATION

SUBJECT: Present Whoreabouts of Bugen DOLLMANN.

- 1. The information in this report was submitted by 00 523.
- 2. In November 1951 SCURCE subsitted information concerning DOLLARN, the former Chief of the Gorman Intelligence in ITALY during world war II, in which it was disclosed that DOLLHANS was living in SWITZERLAND, in the city of Lucano, on Via Loreto \$10. The SOURCE also disclosed that Tallian was in possession of an Italian passport under the name of Engonio AMONN. The passport had been issued to DOLLHANN thru the intervention of the Italian Navy for whom SUBJECT had been of signal service, having been responsible for the entry into ITALY of two nuclear scientists she were allegedly conducting experiments in heavy mater at the Italian navel base of La Spanis (See 3-700-1043 dated 27 November 1951 and S-703-1218 dated 12 North 1952, SUBJECT: Bugen DOLLMANN).
- 3. SCURGE now discloses the details in connection with MONARM's expelsion from SWITZERLAND and his present whereabouts.
- A. Then the Italians had extracted the possibility of COLUMAN being of further use to them, from an informative point of view, the the Italian C.S. (Contro-Spionaggio, Counter Sepionage) was requested to notice DOLIMAN's Italian passport, under the protonce of renowing it. DOLIMANN realizing that the passport would never be returned, had it photographed before releasing it. Then the Swiss Authorities (Sunday Polimai), who had takilly telerated the presence of DOLIMANN in Americal that he no longer was in possession of it they promptly proceeded to aveall him from the Swiss territory. Since DOLIMANN (NOON) Figured as an Italian citizen, because of the photograph of the passport, the Italians were forced to accept him as such.

5. The Italian C.D. took MOLLMANN in custody when he was escorted to the Italo-Dwiss Frontier city of Chiase and was taken to the "Convento Angelicum" (Angelicum Convent) on Piazza Sant'Angelo #2, Milano, directed by the Franciscan Father Superior ZUCCA, Enrico (Fadre Marco F.O.M.). After a stay of about 10 days at the convent, he was very ably escorted by a Franciscan Brother (Father FARINI) to Barcelona, SPAIN, by ship, via Genoa, while furnished with an Italian passport.

- 6. After landing in Barcolona, DOLLY AND was sent to Madrid, where the Italian passport was taken away. Through the intervention of Captain Ivo (BERNUELLER, DOLLMANN made contact with 0. SKORZENY (who headed the parachutist unit which rescued Benito MUSSOLINI in 1943). DOLLMANN is presently under the protection of SKORZENY.
- 7. COLLMANN is still attempting to obtain an Italian passport. It is very doubtful that he will ever obtain a valid document.
- 8. According to SOURCE, DOLLMANN has indicated his intention to write a book of penoirs intitled "Un eros vile" (A Vile Hero).
 SINJECT still boasts of his friendship with Fieldwarshat ALSSELHING, who is said to have recently spoken favorably of BOLLMANN.

AGENT'S NOTE: Father 2000A, the Father Superior of the "Angelians Convent" was involved with the disinterment and the biding of the body of SUSSCILIE.

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
