That would be given the opportunity to decide whether or not he would undertake the CIA assignment. If he so decided the company would not stand in his TIELY.

felt that mas not uniquely qualified for the job, and he felt that there must be somebody also who could carry it on as successfully as

The conversation developed the company's policy, to take to level any call to uniformed service on the basis that he was an indispensable man in any indispensable industry.

5. plans to be in Washington on Saturday, for further conversations with me. I would judge our chance getting his services as not higher than 50-50.
