According to information obtained by this office from a generally reliable informant, Dr. Rudolf DIELE, now of Hof Twenge near Langen-hagen, Kreis Hannover, former Oberregierungsrat in the Prussian Ministry of Interior and first Chief of the Secret State Police Office after 1933, said in Mid-June to an acquaintance, that the "UB Intelligence Service" had approached him and requested his co-operation. DIELS supposedly agreed on the condition that the primary aim of investigations would be the "red net in West-Germany".

In explanation of his statement, DIEIS said, that he intended to prove, that former Communists, but also so-called resistance fighters from other camps, systematically engaged in the task of sabotaging any attempt for a national rally, national regional the recovery of national consciousness.
