## Bulgarian Esigre Activity

1. Mith reference to 80 60309, 02/27, 02/38, and to State Dispatch Me. 27121 from Paris dated 1 Pebroury 1951, the following information was submitted by a well-informed Bulgarian enigre through a fairly reliable source on 13 February 1951.

2. Constantia Shopey has reportedly reseived a letter from Joseph Grey of the Committee for Free Burepe in which the latter asked several Bulgarians to some to the United States "to organize the Metional Counities". Silie Miley, George Potkov, and Shopov were asked to come as well as George Kiosseivenov from Geneva and Ivan T. Balabanov from Hilan. The latter two allegedly have the support of Reas Charron and Royall Tyler of the Committee for Free Europe.

3. It is claimed that Tyler has tald Shepov that he strongly favors Eineseivanov, "former Balgarian Prime Hinister and pro-Hasi lesdar", because he thinks Bulgaria needs a distatorship rather than a demourary. At the same time, Tylar allogadly prefers a consistent with me representatives from the Bulgarian political parties and has accordingly invited Klosselvenov and Ivan Bulahanov to join the committee because they represent the royal family and oppose the Bulgarian political parties.

4. Dimitri Noteenkiev has written a letter to Shopov in which he attacked George M. Disitsov and offered to scoperate with Petkov and Miley in order to control Dimitrov and the committee.

5. At the suggestion of Teocho Tenev and Dianko Sotirov, under the direction of Sava Kirov, all sati-Dimitrov emigres are talking of uniting into one group which would include the "extreme pro-Real Bight" (Ivan Dochey, Stefan Peper); the Paris group of Jerdan Peev, Setirov, Eirov, etc.; and the anti-Disitrov Agrarians (Tenev, Konstantin Mindov, eta). The Democratic Party has also been invited to join this new group but it was stated that Dimiter Keller, former secretary of the party, had refused to do so.
