Operational/Bulgaria  
Interest in GORBATOV and his Followers

Reference: ( ) > 30 August 1954

1. This is to inform you that we have made two operational contacts with GORBATOV (Name A) for the purpose of confirming his statement that he has at his disposal 200 men ready and willing to engage in clandestine operations from Bulgaria. Although we do not at present plan any further contacts with him because we have learned, as we had suspected, that the best he can offer us is some of our own men (e.g. ) back again, we would like to have you keep your ears open in regard to him and his nationalist followers to learn their plans, their channels of contact, the security of their communications, etc. It is entirely possible that we might need or wish at some time in the future to exploit for limited purposes GORBATOV's leadership and recruiting ability. Thus we want to know as much as we can about him and his methods.

2. In listing the candidates in various countries from whom he personally would recruit an operational group of 10 or 15 good men, he named the following in Greece:

3. The following action on your part is requested on a continuing, but non-priority basis:

- a. Pick up what you can unobtrusively from any of the above list with whom you come in contact.
- b. If possible, and not too much trouble, arrange through [ ] for the sponsorship of mail to and from OSAGE. We are particularly anxious to learn with whom he corresponds. We know that he considers his most wanted man in Greece to be MIRONOV and [ ]. Their mail might be censored also.
- c. Keep us informed of what you know already or what you may learn in the future.
- d. We note with interest in connection with OSAGE paragraph 5, p. 2 reference, in which 3 of the 4 men listed are among the names given above. We are therefore anxious to know everything that you can tell us about their spouses for immigration to Canada. It would appear quite probable that OSAGE himself has his hand in the sponsorship at one point. At the moment we are guessing that he might be working through Andre ANDREYEV (ANDREW) (App?), 114 Regent Street, Toronto, since OSAGE himself lives in the same city. As you know ANDREYEV has been known in the past to sponsor Balgarianas.
