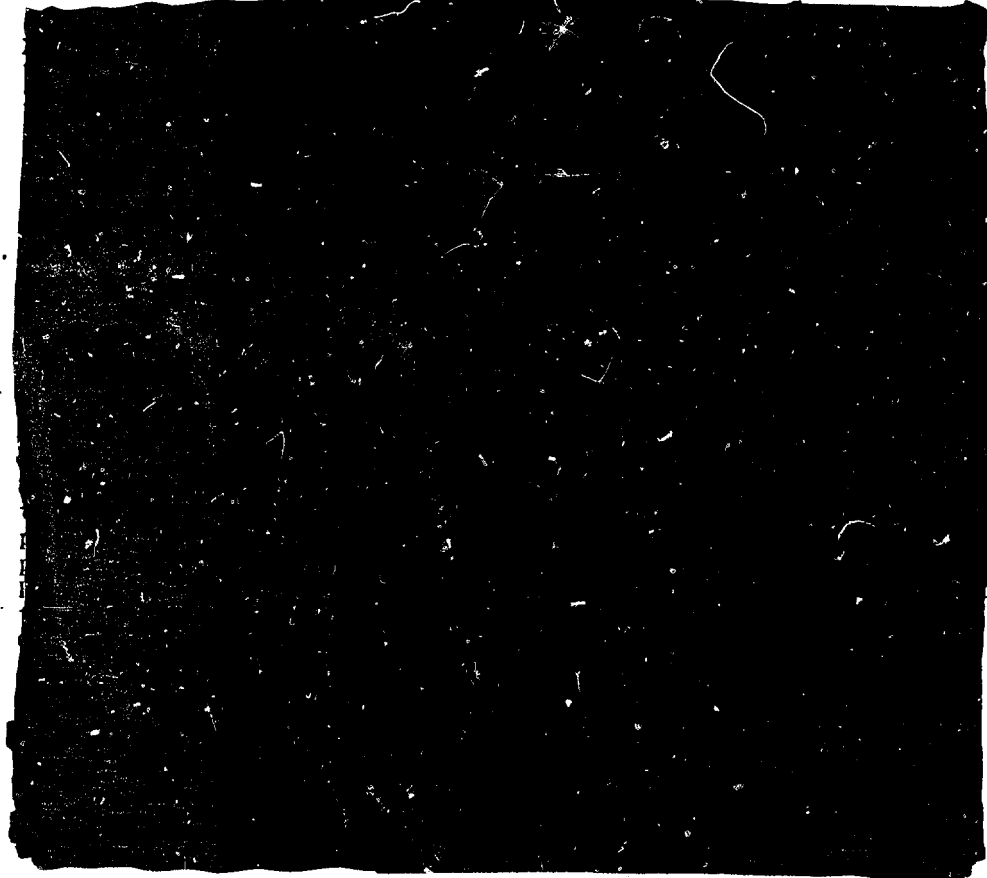

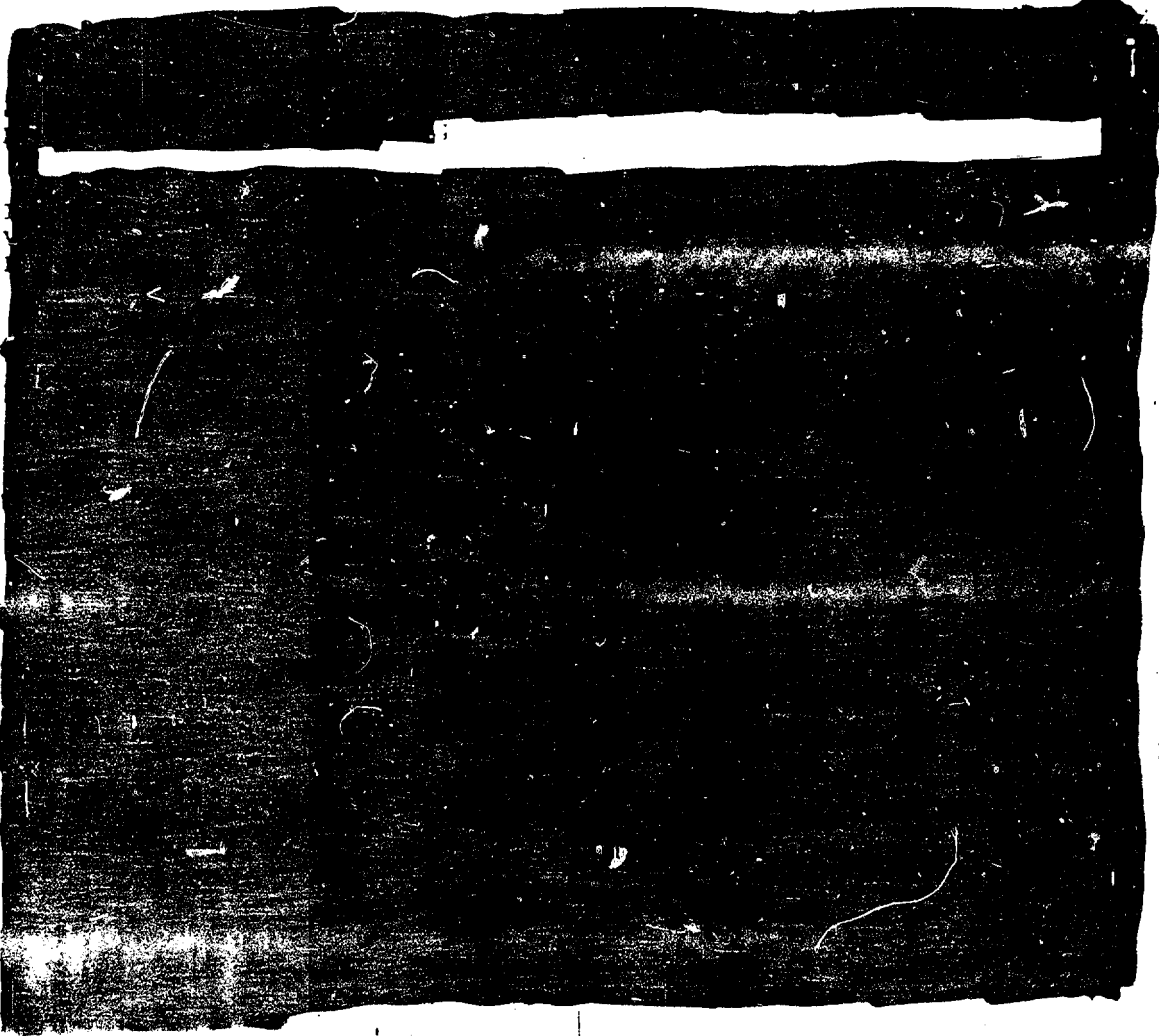

2. [REDACTED], while accompanied by six Viet Cong (VC) troops briefly sighted seven American POW's being escorted along a jungle trail in VC MRTH. Because regiments do not have their own POW camps, Cohn is of the opinion that the seven POW's were taken to POW Camp #1, prior to being evacuated to North Vietnam.
