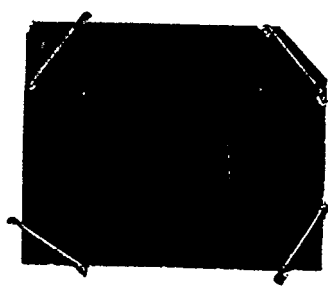

PERTINENT INFORMATION

14. To more important matters, two observations have been made of the drop site and one more of the signal site with some gains. These were afoot. One observation was made by chance in a taxi on the way to the Bol'shoi. Each in turn, as I consult my notes.

6. On Friday, Nov. 25, at 2100 hours Compass walked by the Pushkin St. site. See attached map number 1. The walkby was made from the direction of the Kremlin and along Theatre Street to Gor'kiy after giving the Kremlin Square and the GUM store a complete walk around. The lights in the shoe store were still on and reflected brightly on the street. There was much foot traffic. There were lights still on in the meat store but few customers. It was closing time. Hours are from - another note - 0500 to 1900 hours with lunch from 1300 to 1400. The paper goods shop was closed, so it may be that it is closed on Friday, although Monday is the usual closing day for such shops. Must check that later. As the map indicates there are repairs going on across the street and there is a crane servicing the lifting problems. As I've already mentioned, Compass believes any spot could be permanent surveillance but there is no way to know. It is very easy to establish if they want. After going up Gor'kiy, from observation of the drop site, Compass noted that there was a continuous stream of foot traffic and trucks making food delivery on Kozintskiy Prospekt in both directions as concerns the foot traffic.
