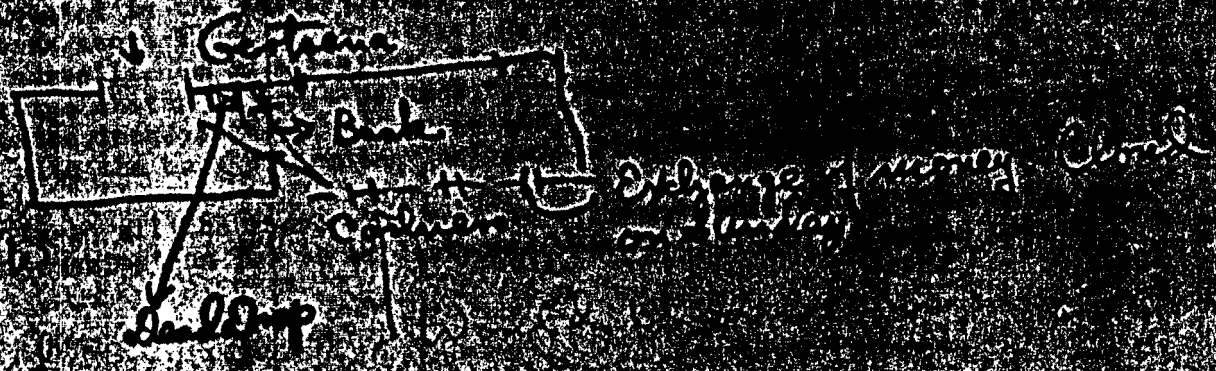

The IGB as reported Building on Dzerzhinskaya Prospekt was observed from the Embassy car on the way to the Dacha on 12/16/46. It is noted that the car was taken because of road conditions and traffic. It was noted that the main building on the ground floor inside the window had a distance between five-eighths and three quarters inches thickness spaced about 1/2 inch apart. There were support bars on the horizontal distance about a half inch thick and two inches wide spaced a distance of one foot apart from top to bottom. A guess this is thought to be of importance for GI if nothing else - is that a building further along on Dzerzhinskaya Ulitsa at about 24 or 26 had the same bars on the inside of the windows and could well be part of the same installation. These steel bars might be a means of identifying the installation as Moscow, and Compass will endeavor to find more in his normal routine observation.

For what it is worth on the left side of the road in the Dacha on Dzerzhinskaya Prospekt is a road of some interest between the 24th and 26th from Moscow is a road to the left of the main road for some vehicles - in the Dacha but for two vehicles. One of them there is a "Volga" (Compass thinks) with number 12 or 13 which passed through without any observation of having presented identification.

The Russian letters on the notes have been noted on green paper to denote that they are Militia cars. Compass will inform you of it.

Just to be sure of some notes in Compass pocket he will have to report the following:

There is a building at 19-22 Kozlovskiy Bulvar which is eight stories high. There are two main side streets which are presumed to be entrances to court-yards at the rear. There are five entrances to various apartments in the building. The bus stop is at Kievskiy Prospekt for the buses 222 and 2102 going towards Chaikovskiy. The Kievskiy Prospekt building is the second building up from the site and on the corner where 222 above on the map. It appears to be at Glazov St. This is a sign of the side of a series of billboards which are the regular Moscow billboards. These are located in the center of the building and best of all that they are set back about 150 feet from the street by a row of always giving protection from surveillance by all angles. However, has not gotten close enough to determine whether it could be used for a dead end or not. Extension from all sides includes that from across the street for a proper guard could be made with the back protecting the person who sets the guard.

Details on all the above will be examined and reported. All the notes made after examination are to be destroyed. Reminders from you are needed.
