1. A MEO VILLAGER FROM THE VICINITY OF UH 9258 SAID THAT ON 20 JULY 1967 SIX AMERICAN PILOTS WERE BEING HELD PRISONERS AT VH 011573, WITHIN THE TOWN OF SAM NEUA. THE PILOTS WERE ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF A TWO-STORY RED BUILDING AND MANY GUARDS LIVED ON THE FIRST FLOOR. THE PILOTS APPEARED TO BE IN POOR PHYSICAL CONDITION. THEY WERE POORLY DRESSED AND HAD NO SHOES.

2. AN ENEMY SOLDIER HAD TOLD THE VILLAGER THAT PREVIOUSLY THERE HAD BEEN EIGHT PILOTS BUT THAT TWO HAD DIED.
