ACTION REQUESTED: Pass to Officers interested in Alfred K. STERN case.

1. There is attached a copy of an article from Excelsior, leading Mexican newspaper which was written by Luis SANCHEZ Ponton, Mexican lawyer who recently went to the U.S.A. (after some difficulty in getting a U.S. visa) for the purpose of attempting to aid Morton SOBELL in getting released from Alcatraz Prison. SOBELL was sentenced to thirty (30) years in the ROSENBERG case.

2. SOBELL was taken to the U.S. border in 1951 by "contacts" of the local FBI representatives; without an official expulsion order by the Mexican Government.

3. The attached is believed of interest because of:

- a. The attack on the FBI.
- b. Present considerations of means of getting Alfred and Martha STERN into the U.S.A. for trial in the Jack SOBELL case.
