SUBJECT: David KEPPEL
Espionage - R

1. With reference to your memorandum dated 18 October 1950, subject as above, this Office will endeavor to contact KEPPEL in Sfax, Tunisia, and conduct the desired interview with him.
2. Before implementing the above, however, it would be appreciated if you could advise us concerning the following points:
 - a. Are the two specific questions contained in your above-referenced memorandum the only ones which you wish put to KEPPEL or do you have other pertinent questions?
 - b. Should it develop that KEPPEL has additional knowledge concerning ROSENBERG or other individuals connected with the FUCHS case, do you wish this knowledge fully explored?
 - c. Is the fact that the interview is being held at the instigation of your Bureau confidential, or is your interest to be disclosed to KEPPEL?
 - d. In the event that the possibility of an extensive interview with subject exists and you desire that such an interview be conducted, will you furnish us with a summary of the case based on information currently in the public domain which may be discussed with subject in order to draw him out during the course of the interview. The majority of the data in our files is classified.
