SUBJECT: Assassination of President Carlos CASTILLO Armas

1. Eusebio VASQUEZ Sanchez, presidential guard who shot President Carlos CASTILLO Armas on 26 July 1957 and then reportedly committed suicide, had previously taken a correspondence course from a radio school in the United States. On 14 May 1953 he received a letter from National Schools, 4000 South Figueroa Street, Los Angeles 37, California.

2. On 17 May 1957 VASQUEZ received an urgent telegram from the same school (presumably in Spanish). It is translated as follows:

17 May 1957

This message is very important for you. We have new study material ready to be sent to you. You will be interested to know that I have received authorization from the accounting department for your account to be considered and brought up-to-date as soon as we receive the payment of a single monthly installment from you.

Do not let any more time pass without acting.
