SHAYEN, NC NOTICEABLE SCARS OR TATTOOS. ONE OF THE GUARDS
PRESENT SAID THE PILOT HAD BEEN A CAPTAIN. THE SECOND PILOT
WAS ABOUT SIX FEET TALL, HEAVY BUILD, WITH SHORT BROWN HAIR;
HE.WAS DESCRIBED BY ONE OF THE GUARDS AS HAVING THE RANK OF
MAJOR. THE PILOT WAS WOUNDED IN THE LEFT LEG AND APPEARED
TO BE UNABLE TO WALK WITHOUT THE HELP OF HIS GUARDS. THE
