SUBJECT : Results of Photo Comparison

1. The following report contains the final technical results of the comparison between the unidentified photo and the wanted photo submitted by your office.

3. In comparing these photos of Major Hartney with photo #45 the following similarities were noted: distinct caliper lines, overhanging lower lip and nose shapes. It should be pointed out that although the noses had similar shapes the nose in photo 45 does not appear as long as Hartney's. Also the area between the nose and the upper lip seems to be larger in #45 than it does in the photos submitted of Hartney. The other features are not distinct enough in #45 to make a comparison.

Upon examining photo #31, it is found that a temporal recession is visible as in the photos of Hartney. The overall head shapes, however, appear to be different. In #31 the head shape is longer and thinner than Hartney's. Photo #31 also gives an impression that the individual possesses a pronounced receding chin, whereas Hartney's chin does not seem as pronounced. Hartney's nose is long with a downward pointing tip -- photo #31 does not.

It is felt that they are not the same individual.
