RESULTS OF PHOTO COMPARISON:

Case 10,30

It should be stated that the POW Photo #45 is of very poor quality. The following analysis is submitted of LComdr DENNISON and POW #45 bearing the foregoing statement in mind: the noses appear different in shape - especially the tip area - the POW seems to have a bulbous tip (this could be due to over-exposure in that area). The distance relationship of the mouth to the nose, and the mouth to the chin is not the same. The POW's mouth appears to be closer to the nose than does DENNISON's. DENNISON's lips appear fuller. The caliper lines in the POW photo seem heavier than DENNISON's.

No other features are distinguishable. It is felt that they are not the same individual.
