Because of widespread violence in neighboring countries, Honduras is host to thousands of refugees. The UN High Commission on Refugees, with support from the World Relief Organization, has set up camps at a number of locations. In the remote northeastern part of the country, a camp at Mococon shelters some 8,000 Miskito Indians who fled from repression in Nicaragua; smaller numbers of Nicaraguan Miskitos live in temporary camps, one near Auca and one near the coast in the vicinity of the border. Besides the Miskitos, some 600 other Nicaraguan exiles have sought refuge in Honduras. They have been given resident status. Most reside in Tegucigalpa, but about 100 still live in and around El Paraiso on the Honduran-Nicaraguan border.
