SUBJECT: DDCI's Question

1. In response to your question, former CIA Station Chief Larry Devlin, in a deposition to the POW/MIA Committee several weeks prior to the hearing, said that he did not recall any meeting with Ross Perot or his associates during their visit to Laos in April 1970. [REDACTED] at a closed hearing on 12 August, he took the same position.

2. We have searched our records here and have uncovered no information which would indicate such a meeting took place. Further record checks are, however, underway.
