THE INSURGENTS HAVE TAKEN RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ASSASSINATION
OF THIRTEEN, INCLUDING SIX AMERICANS, IN JUNE 1985, AND THE
KIDNAPPING OF SALVADORAN [REDACTED] QUARTE'S DAUGHTER IN [REDACTED]
