SUBJECT: Briefing for Representative Duncan Hunter (R., CA)
Regarding Nicaraguan Exports to the FMLN

1. On 16 November 1989 at 1330 hours, in room 133 Cannon House Office Building, Representative Duncan Hunter received a briefing regarding [REDACTED]

2. [REDACTED] Much of the discussion focused on the recent attacks on the military and civilian targets throughout San Salvador; how the insurgents will try and hold their current positions in the suburbs if they are able to obtain supplies; and the number of casualties inflicted on both sides. At the conclusion of the briefing, [REDACTED] said that we had just received word that five Jesuit priests had been killed in San Salvador. He said that the details were sketchy but we do know that they were machinegunned at their residence by unknown assailants. (S)
