SUBJECT: Special Committee Staff Visit to El Salvador

1. Speaker Foley has established a 17-Member Special Committee to investigate the 16 November 1989 murders of six Jesuit Priests and two women in San Salvador. On 8, 9, and 10 January the following staff designees to this Committee will be visiting San Salvador in preparation for a Member trip scheduled for late-January or early-February 1990.

2. Mike O'Neil from Speaker Foley's office will head the staff. Dick Giza (HPSCI), Louis Dupart (Minority staff member of HPSCI), Vic Johnson (Staff Director of House Foreign Affairs Committee, Western Hemisphere Subcommittee), Bill Woodward (Staff Director, Fisheries and Wildlife Subcommittee on Conservation and Environment) and Jim McGovern (from Representative Joe Moakley's, (D., MA), personal staff; Moakley is Chairman of the Special Committee).
