1. AN INDONESIAN AIR FORCE C-130 TRANSPORT PLANE WHICH PARTICIPATED IN THE AIR DROP OVER MALAYSIA ON 2 SEPTEMBER FAILED TO RETURN TO BASE AND IS PRESUMED LOST. SINCE THE PLANE MAINTAINED RADIO SILENCE TO THE END, THE AIR FORCE HEAD-QUARTERS HAS NO IDEA WHERE IT WENT DOWN. THE PLANE CARRIED A CREW OF ELEVEN, COMMANDED BY A MAJOR, NEXT OF KIN HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED.

2. AIR COMMODORE NURTANIO, COMMANDING OFFICER OF HUSEIN AIR BASE SAID ON 5 SEPTEMBER THAT THE C-130 FOLLOWED COMMERCIAL AIRWAYS AND COMMERCIAL AIRLINES PROCEDURES IN
