The regime primarily relied on irregular warfare battalions, which	18
seem to have suffered heavy losses. Managua may calculate that disrupting	19
insurgent infiltration and logistic support is more important than the	20
casualty rate. It likely knew that large numbers of rebels had been	21
resupplied and were still in the base camps. The regime also apparently	22
recognized that it would have to limit its air support because of the	23
possibility of retaliation by the Honduran Air Force.	24
The Sanidinista incursion was not particularly well managed, however,	25
and government forces experienced some logisitics and coordination	26
