THE ORGANIZATION OF PEOPLE IN ARMS (ORPA), A RADICAL LEFTIST GUATEMALAN GROUP, CONTINUES TO HOLD CLIFFORD BEVENS, A U.S. CITIZEN KIDNAPPED BY ORPA IN DECEMBER 1980 IN GUATEMALA CITY. A LEADER OF THE GUATEMALAN NATIONAL REVOLUTIONARY UNION (URN), WHICH COMPRISES THE FOUR MAJOR RADICAL LEFTIST GUATEMALAN GROUPS, SAID THAT ORPA PLANS TO BE VERY PATIENT IN CONNECTION WITH THE KIDNAPPING OF BEVENS, WHO IS THE GENERAL MANAGER OF A SUBSIDIARY OF THE GOODYEAR TIRE AND RUBBER COMPANY IN GUATEMALA. HE SAID THAT ORPA LEADERS BELIEVE THAT THEY MAY HAVE TO HOLD BEVENS FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD BEFORE THEIR DEMAND FOR
