TRADE RELATIONS MAY BE CLASSIFIED AS ABSOLUTELY NORMAL. THERE HAS BEEN NO
SIGNIFICANT REDUCTION IN ECONOMIC AND TECHNICAL AID AND, ALTHOUGH ON OC-
CATION POINTS OF DIFFERENCE DO ARISE, THE GENERAL SITUATION APPEARS TO BE
PROGRESSING AS PLANNED. THE COOLNESS IN CUBAN-SOVIET RELATIONS IS, RATHER,
IN THE POLITICAL ARENA, BUT THIS HAS HAD NO EFFECT ON COMMERCIAL RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES.

HEAD OF THE CUBAN ACADEMY OF SCIENCE, RETURNED RECENTLY FROM THE USSR; HE ADVISED THAT EVERYTHING [redacted] INCLUDING THE REACTOR, WOULD NOW BE PROVIDED. [redacted] COMMENT: ON 15 SEPTEMBER 1967 HAVANA DOMESTIC NEWS SERVICE ANNOUNCED SIGNING OF A USSR-CUBA AGREEMENT WHEREBY CUBA WOULD BE GIVEN A NUCLEAR REACTOR AND RELATED RESEARCH LABORATORIES. NO OFFICIAL CUBAN ANNOUNCEMENT OF FRENCH TECHNICAL COLLABORATION HAS BEEN FORTHCOMING ALTHOUGH HAVANA RADIO IN OCTOBER 1967 BROADCAST THAT NUNEZ WAS ON A STUDY TOUR IN FRANCE DISCUSSING PROSPECTS FOR SCIENTIFIC EXCHANGES AND COLLABORATION BETWEEN CUBA AND FRANCE.)
