DETAILS

[REDACTED] is the star news announcer and commentator of [REDACTED] station XORS, Shanghai. This man comes on the air at 10:45 o'clock every morning and has been babbling over the radio for a number of years, being out-and-out anti-Allied. He is extremely eloquent and is undoubtedly head and shoulders above the other renegades of his category who are now serving the enemy in propaganda work in the field of broadcasting.

The station XORS broadcasts on a frequency of 11.4 MC (wave length 25 met.).

Information has been received that he has a brother somewhere in Free China.

Informant passed through Yeung Kong recently and he met the Bishop of the Catholic Mission there, an American. In a conversation between him and the Bishop, the latter disclosed that recently one of the Fathers of the Mission happened to talk to some other persons about Herbert Moy and his pro-Japanese activities. Apparently the Father did not speak very highly of him. It so happened that among the audience was a brother of Herbert Moy. He stood up and said that although he was Moy's brother, he nevertheless agreed with what the Father had said.

There is no evidence to suggest that the brother in question is similarly inclined in politics as the notorious Herbert. However, in view of the fact that Herbert is an inveterate traitor, the authorities concerned may wish to know where he is, in which case, it is recommended that they get in touch with the Bishop of the Catholic Mission at Yeung Kong.

Herbert has a relative in Hongkong working for the enemy and another relative, Elizabeth Moy, in Kwailin, private secretary to the S.O., S.O.S., Advance Section No. 1, Sub Office.
