FRONT FOR THE LIBERATION OF SOUTH VIETNAM ENTERED TAY NINH PROVINCE
AND STATIONED THEMSELVES AT DON THUAN (APPROXIMATELY XT 380420),
KHIEM HANH DISTRICT, IN THE BOI LOI SECRET ZONE. SUBSEQUENTLY
ABOUT 1,000 OF THESE VC TROOPS MOVED TO TRA VONG (COORDINATES
UNAVAILABLE), PHUOC NINH DISTRICT: (FIELD COMMENT.
