- On 13 September CHAO Erh-lu (趙爾陸), a staff member of the Central and South China Military Area headquarters, after inspecting a camp for American and British prisoners of war at 52 Fu Hsing (復興) Road, Shameen, Canton, issued an order prohibiting prisoners from speaking to people outside the compound.1
- Names of some of the prisoners in this camp from the United States Eighth Army, the British Gloucester Regiment, and the British Argyll Battalion are as follows:

1. [REDACTED] Comment. [REDACTED] about 170 United States prisoners of war arrived in Canton on 5 October, and were taken to the former American consulate building on Shameen. No pedestrian was permitted to approach closer than 50 meters to the compound. Other recent reports on prisoners of war in Canton may be found [REDACTED]
2. [REDACTED] The report also contained the following information: [REDACTED] was also reported as 2nd lieutenant Mrcaf. Li-k'o-erh was also reported as Warrant Officer Lehareer. Pu-chi was also reported as Warrant Officer Botje. It is not clear whether this additional information was written into the diary by the interpreter, or whether it was supplied by the source.
