SUBJECT: SCC Meeting: Security Framework Follow-Up

2. Background. Yesterday the NSC scheduled the subject SCC meeting for tomorrow afternoon. Dr. Brzezinski has not yet selected the agenda to be discussed from a long list of pending items including US base/access rights, U.S. contingency plans, and his own trip to Pakistan and Saudi Arabia. 3. The most recent SCC on the general subject was the 31 January meeting on Indian Ocean Access (Tab B). Bruce Clarke attended and reported that its sole purpose was to review and approve the instructions for the State/Defense team that visited Kenya, Somalia, Oman, and Saudi Arabia (Tab C).
