1. Action Requested: None; for your information. (U)

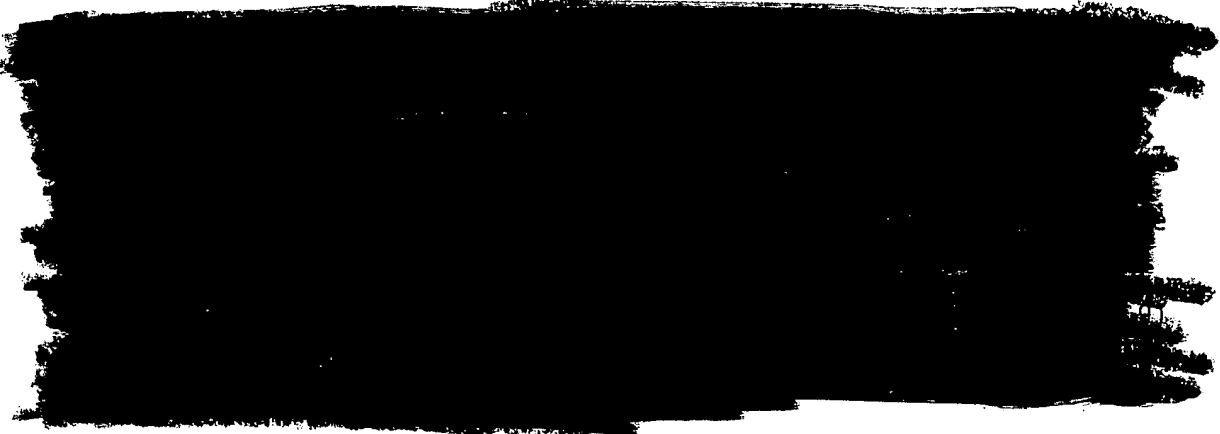
