She arrived here and asked the help of Dutch Int. in getting these questions answered. This was done and she was immediately recruited by them. This was the middle of Dec 1944.

R E L E A S E

This RELEASE entered into by (1) Mary A.H. Gentis  
and (2) Frank B. Jex, 1st Lt. AGD on the 31st day of May 1945.

W I T N E S S E T H:

1. That Mary A.H. Gentis has received the sum of  
(3) 1200 guilders in full and final settlement of any and  
all obligations under or arising out of any real or purported  
past or present employment or any real or purported contract,  
agreement or undertaking for any past, present, or future  
employment by or on behalf of the United States Government, its  
officers, agents or employees.

2. In consideration of the payment referred to in para-  
graph 1 hereof, (4) Mary A.H. Gentis RELEASES the United  
States Government and any officer(s), agent(s), or employee(s)  
of such Government, or any person who has in the past purported  
to be an officer, agent, or employee of such Government, from  
any and all debts, claims, compensation benefits, demands, or  
causes of action, including claims under any law of the United  
States or any other nation now in force or hereinafter enacted,  
arising out of or by reason of any such real or purported past  
or present employment or real or purported contract, agreement,  
or undertaking for any past, present or future employment.

3. Nothing in this RELEASE shall be deemed to constitute  
a representation that any contract, agreement or undertaking  
has been entered into by the United States Government or by  
any officer, agent, or employee of such Government duly author-  
ized by law to enter into any obligation which would create  
rights in law or in equity enforceable against such Government  
in the courts of the United States or in the courts of any  
other nation.
