RVV people would not let her go, but then suggested that she go through the lines for them to make contact with the Govt here and obtain answers to certain political and economic questions.

She arrived here and asked the help of Dutch Int. in getting these questions answered. This was done and she was immediately recruited by them. This was the middle of Dec 1944.





This RELEASE entered into by (1) Mary A.H. Gentis and (2) Frank B. Jex, 1st It. ACD on the 31st day of May 1945.

WITNESSETH:

Gentis has received the sum of (3) 1200 guilders in full and final settlement of any and all obligations under or arising out of any real or purported past or present employment or any real or purported contract, agreement or undertaking for any past, present, or future employment by or on behalf of the United States Government, its officers, agents or employees.
