1. Receipt is hereby acknowledged of your memorandum dated 21 July 1945 with reference to injuries sustained by the above named individuals, who, I understand, are civilian employees of this agency.

2. As required by statute, I have given notice of the injuries to the U.S. Employees Compensation Commission, and I am enclosing herewith Comp. Form 124, ETO, to be completed and returned to me in triplicate. If claim is made by the employee for salary payments, he should sign the form on the line provided for his signature, and if the circumstances are such that the employee does not have a valid claim you should simply fill out the form and sign your name on the line captioned, "Reporting Officer".

3. As employees of the U.S. Government, the above-named claimants are entitled to receive compensation payments at the statutory rate (prescribed percentage of base salary) during the time they are disabled and not paid by the Government. They are also entitled to payment for medical and hospital services.

4. Upon returning the enclosed forms, kindly send me copies of the employees' contracts of employment and if formal contracts were not signed, a statement setting forth the terms of employment and the salaries paid.
