Popular support for radical leftist priest Jean-Bertrand Aristide's presidential bid has surged since mid-October, leaving opponents grappling with how to counter his candidacy. Aristide **Factoria** attracted as many as 130,000 people in two recent rallies. Most business leaders believe an Aristide victory would be "disastrous" and are providing substantial funding to centrist and moderate leftist
