MISSION. Main task to identify any units of the 19th Army which have moved
into the area covered. ~~Required~~ *Essential* information, including divisional insignia has been given.

Any indication of a par division in the area covered. Particular attention to LANDAU in this connection.

Particular emphasis on the HQ at Wachenheim, which is the most important single spot to be visited on the route.

Most important axis on which to observe movement is the route from KAISERSLAUTERN to HOMBOURG to SAARBRUCKEN. What sort of equipment is on the move here. Numbers and type of units involved.

DUMPS AND DEPOTS. What is at ENKENBACH? Size, type, defenses, activity, etc
